Pool Facility Rules

2009

- 1) Yorktown Pool facilities are for Yorktown residents only and their guests.
- 2) All residents must show a valid ID card
- 3) All persons leaving the pool facility must show an ID or ticket to reenter.
- 4) A maximum of two (2) guests allowed per card holder.
- 5) Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 6) No swimming unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- 7) Do not distract lifeguards.
- 8) Lap lanes are for lap swimming only. Hanging on lap lane lines is prohibited.
- 9) Obey all instructions of pool personnel.
- 10) Proper swim attire required in the pools.
- 11) Ladders are for entering and leaving the pool only.
- 12) Swimming alone is a poor practice.
- 13) All pool users must shower before entering the pool.
- 14) Children who are not toilet trained must wear rubber pants over diapers or swim diapers (available at the pool manager's office).
- 15) Wade pools are for children ages 6 and under and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- 16) Brian J. Slavin Aquatic Facility Interactive Pool
 - No running or jumping on or around the water play unit.
 - Children using the interactive pool must be at least 41" tall.
 - No climbing on pipes or handrails.
 - No hanging or climbing on pull ropes.
- 17) Junior Lake Pool Slide
 - Children using the slide must be at least 41" tall.
 - Only one person on the slide at a time.

NOT PERMITTED

- 1) Masks, fins, snorkels or other similar devices.
- 2) Artificial means of support, ie: floats, tubes, jackets, etc.
- 3) Running on the pool decks and walks.
- 4) Hanging on swim lane dividers and ropes.
- 5) Swimming during a storm.
- 6) Swimming with infections, open wounds or sores.
- 7) Smoking, food, drinks in the pool area.
- 8) Pets in the pool area except guide dogs.
- 9) Horseplay of any kind including any conduct infringing on the welfare of others.

Sparkle Lake Beach Facility Rules

- 1) The Sparkle Lake Beach facility is for Yorktown residents only and their guests.
- 2) Proof of residency only will be required to use Sparkle Lake Beach.
- 3) Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4) No swimming unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- 5) Do not distract the lifeguards.
- 6) Swimmers must stay within the designated swimming area.
- 7) Swimming alone is a poor practice.
- 8) Proper swim attire required in the water.
- 9) Obey all instructions of beach personnel.

NOT PERMITTED

- 1) Masks, fins, snorkels or other similar devices.
- 2) Artificial means of support ie: floats, tubes, jackets, etc
- 3) Horseplay of any kind, including any conduct infringing on the welfare of others.
- 4) Swimming during a storm.
- 5) Swimming with infections, open wounds or sores.
- 6) Smoking, food, drinks in the beach area.
- 7) Pets in beach area except guide dogs.
