## Tennis Court Rules & Regulations

### 2009

As a cost saving measure, the Town of Yorktown Parks and Recreation Department will be operating the tennis courts under a new system. All courts will be chained and locked. Upon purchasing a permit, permit holders will be given a key that unlocks the tennis gates. A supervisor will also be patrolling the facilities and will spot check players to be sure that they have permits. Gates will be locked May 26<sup>th</sup> through Labor Day weekend.

#### **Tennis Court Rules**

- Residents must have a current permit to use the courts. Upon purchase of a permit, a key will be given which will provide access to the courts.
- One key will be given per household. If a family tennis permit is purchased, an additional key may be purchased for \$5.00.
- A supervisor will be checking players for valid permits. If a valid permit is not produced, the player will be asked to leave the facility.
- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to make sure the gate is locked when he/she leaves the court.
- A maximum of two guests are allowed per tennis permit holder.

#### **Playing Time**

- Please be courteous to other residents and play within the allotted time when people are waiting.
- Singles play is allowed 1 hour
- Doubles play is allowed 1 ½ hours
- Once finished, players must wait 3 hours to play again. This is to allow other residents the opportunity to play.

#### **Facilities**

- Downing Park (6 courts) – Courts are lighted and are open until 10:00pm, weather permitting.
- Yorktown High School (4 courts)
- Blackberry Woods (3 courts)

#### **Guest Fees**

- Ages 18 & over           \$5.00
- Ages 3-17                 \$3.00

#### **Lost Card Fee**

If you lose your card during the course of the season, a \$5.00 replacement card fee will be charged. Allow 5 business days for processing.
